## **RFID - The Hottest Buzz of the Show**

The hottest buzz of this year's show was the introduction of RFID.

RFID (Radio Frequency Identification) allows refuse companies to record pick up times of all the customers on their route. Another feature they are working on is finalizing the integration of measuring weight.

Imagine how powerful it would be to be able to know (within a 1 LB variation) exactly how much a customer's waste weighed. This could change the billing model completely. Another part of the RFID system is the integration of a camera, allowing refuse companies the ability to document the status of a pickup to verify if customers are going over their limit (also assisting in accurate billing). The front loader driver will also be able to know if a customer is not paid and have the hydraulics for a specific container turn off and refuse to operate. This would eliminate the ability for drivers to pick up extra waste unpaid or for them to be paid under the table for what would be considered an extra haul. This is something you'll definitely want to keep your eye on in the future!
